## SUSIE HAMILTON

Susie Hamilton studied Fine Art at St Martins School of Art and Byam Shaw School of Art and read English Literature at London University, gaining a PhD in Shakespeare studies in 1989. Since 1996 she had been represented by Paul Stolper Gallery, London and has exhibited widely in the UK and abroad with solo shows in Moscow and Oslo. Since 2018 she has also been commissioned by the mental health charity Hospital Rooms to create wall-paintings in psychiatric intensive care units. A major monograph of her work was published by Anomie in October 2024 and 'Underground', a book of her drawings on the London tube, published by Hurtwood in October 2025.
